Before we begin let us gather together and light our special candle.

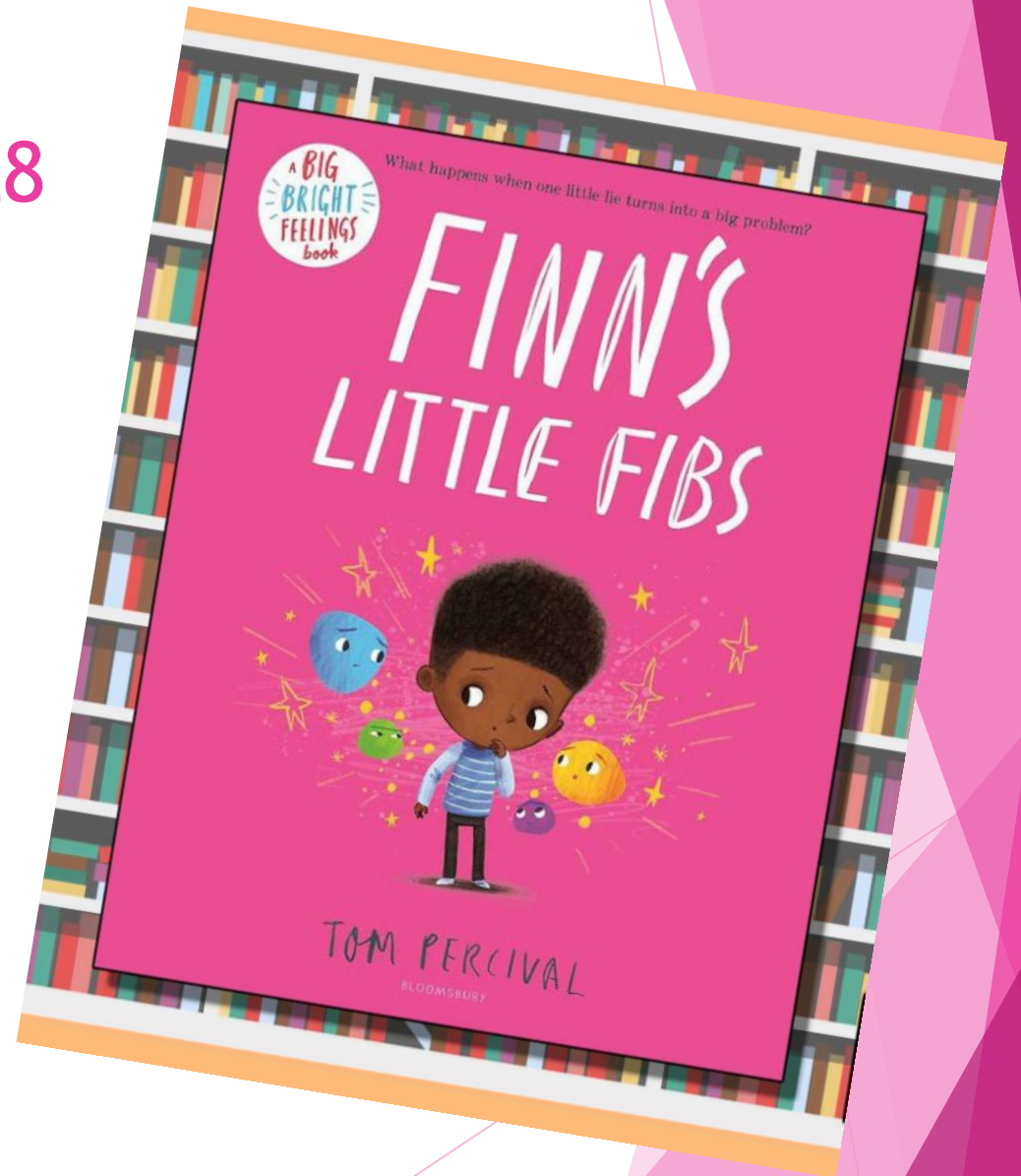
Leader: "Let us live our vision of."

What happened when Fin told his first little fib?

(Helps children think about the start of the problem.)

How did Fin feel when his fibs started to grow bigger?

(Encourages them to reflect on the emotions involved in lying.)

What did Fin do to fix his mistake and tell the truth?

(Teaches the importance of making things right after lying.)

How did Fin's friends feel when he told them the truth?

(Helps children understand the impact of honesty on relationships.)

What can we learn from Fin's story about telling the truth?

(Encourages them to think about the lesson of the story and how it applies to their own

Responding and quiet reflection

If you were one of Fin's friends, how would you feel when you found out the truth?

(Adult note: Helps children understand how honesty can affect relationships.)

Sending: As we leave our collective worship “We go into the world to walk in God’s light, to rejoice in his love. Amen.”
